4 **The Council of the City of Moundsville met in Regular Session in the Council Chambers on**  
5 **October 17, 2006 at 7:00 p.m.**

6  
7 **Meeting was called to order by Mayor Dennis Wallace.**

8  
9 **Invocation by Councilperson Mark Simms.**

10  
11 **City Clerk called the roll and the following council persons were in attendance: Vice Mayor**  
12 **DiRemigio, Haynes, Lemasters, Oiler, Simms, Wood and Mayor Wallace. Also present: City**  
13 **Manager Hendershot, Police Chief Kudlak, Fire Chief Clarke, Street Foreman Chuck Richmond,**  
14 **Building Inspector Vickers, Attorney Thomas White and City Clerk Hewitt. Absent: Street**  
15 **Commissioner Richmond and CPA Thomas Dobbs.**

19 **Regular Council Meeting of October 3, 2006.**

20  
21 **Vice Mayor DiRemigio made a motion to accept and approve the minutes of the regular council**  
22 **meeting of October 3, 2006, seconded by Councilperson Lemasters. Motion carried unanimously.**

24 **GENERAL PUBLIC HEARING:**

25  
26 **Dedication to Former Mayors of the City of Moundsville.**

27  
28 **Mayor Wallace and City Manager Hendershot presented Former Mayors and/or their family**  
29 **member with a certificate and key to the city pin. Included in the dedication were: Shelley Gorby,**  
30 **grand daughter of Louis Joseph; Mr. & Mrs. Clifford Bucy; Mr. Randy Chamberlain; Mr. & Mrs.**  
31 **James Stultz; Mrs. William Daugherty; Mr. Mark Simms; Mr. Ralph DiRemigio and Mr. Dennis**  
32 **Wallace.**

34 **\* David White, 406 Clinton Avenue, inquired about the Motorcycle Officer/Bicycle Cop and a**  
35 **house on Clinton Avenue.**

37 **NEW BUSINESS:**

39 **Discussion and Approval of an Ordinance to Adopt Replacement Pages to the Municipal**  
40 **Code Book. (First Reading)**

41  
42 **Vice Mayor DiRemigio made a motion to accept the ordinance pertaining to replacement pages of**  
43 **the City ordinance book, seconded by Councilperson Wood.**

1 Mayor Wallace called for a voice vote. City Clerk announced the following tally. 7 yeas. Motion  
2 carried unanimously.

4 **Discussion and Approval of Requisition #11 for the Moundsville Water Treatment Plant.**

5  
6 Councilperson Oiler made a motion to approve Requisition #11 for the Moundsville Water  
7 Treatment Plant, seconded by Councilperson Lemasters. Motion carried unanimously.  
8

9 **Other Items to be Discussed by Council.**

10  
11 \* Councilperson Oiler asked Manager Hendershot to discuss the streets to be paved in October.  
12 Manager Hendershot reported the bids were received from Klug Brothers. The bids were within  
13 the range expected by the engineer. Concerns were expressed on timing and cold weather.  
14 Manager Hendershot is working with Klug's to allow them a 30 day completion date instead of 60  
15 days. Also, if the temperature would drop below 50 degrees, the wear coat would not be put on  
16 until next spring.  
17

18 Manager Hendershot recommended to pave Ohio Street and Eighth Street since Locust Avenue  
19 needs more base work.  
20

21 Councilperson Oiler made a motion to pave Ohio Street and Eighth Street from Henrietta Avenue  
22 to Annadale Avenue, seconded by Councilperson Simms.  
23

24 After further discussion, Councilperson Oiler wished to amend his motion and Councilperson  
25 Simms amended his second to pave Ohio Street, Eighth Street from Henrietta to Annadale and  
26 Locust Avenue, weather permitting and under good judgement by Klug Brothers. Motion carried  
27 unanimously.

29 \* Councilperson Simms asked Building Inspector Vickers if he was aware of the bug problem at  
30 1015 Tomlinson Avenue. Mr. Vickers said he was taking care of the complaint.

34 **Business After Hours.**

36 The Marshall County Chamber of Commerce will be hosting a Business After Hours on October  
37 25, 2006, sponsored by the MEDC and WalMart at the NCLETTTC Training Building from 5-7

40 **Grievance Hearing Scheduled by Council.**

41  
42 Manager Hendershot announced that a fourth step grievance has been filed by one of the city's  
43 employees. The fourth step requires council to schedule a hearing. Council must have a quorum  
44 to conduct the hearing.

1 Councilperson Wood made a motion to schedule the grievance hearing on Wednesday, November  
2 8, 2006 at 6:00 p.m., seconded by Councilperson Simms. Motion carried unanimously.

4 **Other Items to be Discussed by the City Manager.**

5  
6 Attorney White submitted legal ads published in the Moundsville Daily Echo to be received and  
7 filed by council.

8  
9 Councilperson Oiler made a motion to receive and file the legal ads, seconded by Vice Mayor  
10 DiRemigio. Motion carried unanimously.

12 **MAYOR ITEMS:**

14 **Appointment to the Planning Commission Liaison Member.**

15  
16 Mayor Wallace appointed Paul Haynes as Liaison Member to the Moundsville Planning  
17 Commission.

19 **Other Items to be Discussed by the Mayor.**

21 \* Mayor Wallace is urging all citizens to vote on November 7, 2006.

23 **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

24  
25 **Discussion and Approval of Recommendations by the Traffic Committee.**

26  
27 1. Discussion of a Request for a "Children at Play" sign on north Sycamore Avenue  
28 between Center Street and Highland Avenue. And on Second Street between Court  
29 Avenue and Tomlinson Avenue.

30  
31 After some discussion, Councilperson Simms made a motion to install a "Children at  
32 Play" sign on Second Street between Court Avenue and Tomlinson Avenue, seconded by  
33 Councilperson Haynes. Motion carried unanimously.

34  
35 2. Discussion of a request to install street lights on Park Street between Oak Avenue and  
36 Walnut Avenue. And at the 1400 block of Seventh Street.

37  
38 After discussion, council agreed to replace bulbs with brighter watts on street lights that  
39 Manager Hendershot, Vice Mayor DiRemigio and Councilperson Haynes find to be dim.

41 **COUNCIL ITEMS:**

43 \* **Haynes** - Reported to Chief Kudlak speeders on Sandy Avenue.

45 \* Asked that the curb on both sides of a driveway be painted yellow at 76 Oak Avenue.

1 \* **Lemasters** - Nothing at this time.  
2  
3 \* **DiRemigio** - Noted that he checked with the same bank that the city is receiving 3% interest and  
4 can receive 5.5% interest. Manager Hendershot reported that he has already spoke with Mr.  
5 Dobbs and the monies have been moved to the higher interest rate.  
6  
7 \* **Wood** - Asked who is responsible for repaving the street at 5<sup>th</sup> & Tomlinson Avenue. Manager  
8 Hendershot noted that the City Sanitary is partly responsible.  
9  
10 \* Inquired on the Jefferson Avenue Extension sidewalk. Manager Hendershot reported that he is  
11 still working with Jack Tush and Bob Whipp of DOH. Information is nearly ready to be sent to  
12 Charleston for approval.  
13  
14 \* **Simms** - Asked that Manager Hendershot speak with Phil Remke concerning WV Hall of Fame  
15 in Moundsville.  
16  
17 \* Announced that he is voting in favor of the School Bond Levy and hopes that all citizens vote  
18 on November 7, 2006.  
19  
20 \* **Oiler** - Reported the street needing fixed at 7<sup>th</sup> & Lockwood Avenue.  
21  
22 \* Congratulations to the former Mayors and their families.  
23  
24 \* Urged all citizens to vote.  
25  
26 Councilperson Oiler made a motion to have an Executive Session for contractual matters,  
27 seconded by Councilperson Lemasters. Motion carried unanimously.  
28  
29 Meeting recessed at 7:55 p.m.

2 carried unanimously.
