23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34	City Manager Healy read the highlights of the Indoor Environmental Fungal Assessment provided by SDI Environmental. The airbourne fungal levels (mold spores) registered an abnormal fungal ecology; there are high levels of moisture and water intrusion entering from a roof breach which is causing very high levels humidity amplifying mold growth; active mold on surfaces along with stagnate contaminated water producing an extremely pungent moldy odor; wood floor damage as well as severe ceiling and wall plaster degradation from the water intrusion; airflow is very limited in the areas due to the type of HVAC system. In order to correct these issues, it is recommended a professional mold remediation contractor with appropriate certifications and licenses perform the work. And, before any repair work proceeds, WV statute requires that a NESHAP Asbestos Assessment be performed on any building materials that may be disturbed or removed.
