## **ATTENTION**

Moundsville Water Board with the assistance of Marshall County Emergency Management are providing a Wireless Emergency Notification System (WENS) for the residents of the county. By signing up, you will receive alerts and public service announcements in the event of a water break or outage along with any emergency or weather warnings in your area. An alert may be sent to the phone or phones you provide and/or your email address.

This is a free service provided by the county, however, normal message and data rates may apply. To receive text messages to your cell phone, your phone must have text messaging capabilities.

\*\* Please note that if you register through text or on the website, you will need to notify Water Board office staff so that you may be added to the group to receive information specific to water outages, boil orders, etc.

## MARSHALL COUNTY EMERGENCY ALERTS NETWORK

By signing up here, you will receive Marshall County emergency alerts and public service announcements. In the event of an emergency or weather warnings, an alert may be sent to the phone number(s) you provide and/or your email address. You will also be notified of water line breaks, outages, and boil orders specific to your location.

This is a FREE service provided by the Marshall County Emergency Management and 911 Center, however, standard data and message rates may apply. To receive text messages to your cell phone, your cell phone must have text messaging capabilities. Notifications are dependent upon external providers (phone carrier, cell phone, email). By registering, you will not receive unsolicited calls and neither Marshall County nor its system vendor sells the contact number database.

All users are automatically registered for Blizzard, Civil Danger, Earthquake, Fire, Flash Flood, Hazmat, Heavy Snow, Ice Storm, Law Enforcement, Nuclear Power Plant, Radiological Hazard, Shelter in Place, Tornado, and Winter Storm Warnings.
